Studio 2724 - Custom Quilts - FAQ's

The following questions and answers should help explain the process of commissioning a quilt. Please call with additional questions or when ready to discuss the specifics of a commission.

What is the lead time for commissions?

Delivery of custom quilts average 8–12 weeks and will be confirmed at the time of ordering.

Are any of the quilts in the Artist's Private collection available for purchase?

Yes, occasionally I can be persuaded to part with one of my personal quilts, but otherwise, I can make any of these quilts to order.

Is there a standard to the size of quilts?

Yes! Approximate sizes are: Wall hanging 38" x 46" or 40" x 40", Napping 48" x 72", Twin 65" x 90", Queen 86" x 92", King 102" x 92". Standard bed quilt sizes are based on a 10"–13" drop at the sides and foot of the mattress and vary by design. The exact quilt dimensions will be specified in a commission agreement.

I have an antique bed with an unusual mattress size. Can you customize the quilt to fit?

Certainly, custom sizes can be designed and made for an additional cost.

I have a four-poster bed. Can you create a quilt with corner cutouts?

Yes. Some designs lend themselves to such an adaptation better than others. Please call for details and pricing.

How can I know exactly what I'll be getting?

I draw up a commission agreement for every order. The agreement clearly states details including the design, size, colors, quilting pattern and thread color, type of batting, backing fabric, delivery date and shipping cost so that you know just what you'll be getting.

Will my quilt be identical to one shown on the website?

Each quilt is unique. I keep to the spirit of the original but fabrics go out of print quickly and dye lots vary, so the fabrics and colors may vary from those shown. I offer a swatch approval service if you need to see exact fabrics.

Do you design custom quilts?

Absolutely. If you are interested in a one-of-a-kind or site-specific quilt, please call me with one of those options, then we'll draw up a commission agreement and I'll make the quilt.

Are quilts returnable?

Custom quilts are each made to order, so all sales are final.

How can I pay for my commission?

Custom commissioned orders must be prepaid. I accept company or personal checks.

How do you ship?

Quilts are shipped insured and will require a signature for delivery. The shipping and insurance costs (additional to the cost of the quilt) and must be prepaid before shipping. I use FedEx or UPS for most shipments.
